BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES
January 24, 2017**

The special meeting of the Webb City R-7 Board of Education was called to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Webb City High School, 621 North Madison, Webb City, Missouri by Dan McGrew, President.

Guests at the meeting included R-7 administrator Dr. Anthony Rossetti, Dr. Trey Moeller, Dr. Kevin Cooper and Dr. Brenten Byrd.

Resign: Sauls

Allison Sauls, family and consumer sciences teacher at the Webb City Junior High, has submitted her letter of resignation effective at the end of the 2016-2017 school year. A motion was made by David Collard to accept the letter of resignation. The motion was seconded by Jason Woodmansee and was unanimously approved.

Turf Bids

Kevin Cooper, Assistant Superintendent of Business Operations, provided the Board with copies of the bids received for the turf project. The following three companies submitted bids: Byrne and Jones, Mid-America Sports and ATG Sports. David Collard made a motion to accept the bid from Byrne & Jones in the amount of \$561,700. The motion was seconded by Kevin Crane and was unanimously approved.

Beacon Contract

David Collard made a motion to renew the contract with Beacon School. The motion was seconded by Kevin Crane and was unanimously approved.

Discussion of Eugene Field & Mark Twain

The Board discussed options regarding our third and fourth grade enrollment at Eugene Field Elementary and Mark Twain Elementary. The third grade enrollment at Mark Twain was closed at the beginning of the 2016-2017 school year due to class size. We added a third grade teacher at Eugene Field Elementary to help

with the enrollment increase. The past couple of years we have had to keep a close eye on the third and fourth grade classroom sizes at both of these attendance centers. The Board will have more discussion on this matter at the February board meeting.
