



WEBB CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT-MERCY CLINIC – FAQ’S

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is a School Based Health Clinic (SBHC)?

Students perform better when they show up for class healthy and ready to learn. School Based Clinics provide care – primary health, mental health and counseling, family outreach, and chronic illness management – without concern for the student’s ability to pay and in a location that meets students where they are at school.

Do all students of Webb City School District have access to the SBHC?

YES. All students will have access to the SBHC after they have consulted with their particular school nurse.

Do I have to allow my child to use the clinic?

NO. Current nursing services are always available by the school district. Any student that wishes to seek the services of the SBHC must have a signed consent form on file.

Who can be seen at this?

All students, faculty and staff of the Webb City School District and their immediate family members can use the clinic.

What services are provided at the Mercy SBHC?

The SBHC, located in Webb City High School, is intended to provide health care services for students/faculty/staff of the district, child daycare of the district, and immediate family members of those students or employees of the district. Services provided are that of which most family practice clinics provide and may include (but are not limited to):

- Physical exams (General, Sport, Wellness)
- Diagnosis and treatment of minor and acute illness or first aid for small injuries including lacerations
- When necessary, prescription medication for treatment of current illnesses or other pre-existing conditions
- In clinic testing for strep throat, flu and urinary tract infection
- Assistance with chronic (on-going) illnesses (ie diabetes, blood pressure, etc)
- Laboratory services
- Immunizations (For commercial insurance, not Medicaid)

What is the cost and how does my current insurance plan fit in?

Individual health insurance plans will be subject to those plan benefits and charges. For staff and students with private health insurance and/or who are eligible for Medicare or Medicaid, the SBHC is permitted to charge for the cost of services. Most insurance plans are accepted and many are in-network.

Will my child’s medical information be kept confidential?

YES. Your child’s health information will be treated with strict confidentiality. By signing the consent form you are only giving the clinic staff permission to communicate and share medical information to other health professionals involved in your child’s care regarding your child’s medical condition. Patient care information will not be shared with the school district.

Where is this clinic located?

Mercy School Based Health Clinic is located inside the high school, next to the front office. Webb City School District will provide transportation from your child’s particular school, to the high school clinic if needed.
